
Among the most important quality parameters for the fruits product, that are regularly inspected and granted by the company, can be listed:

William pears are on sale from August to November. It is a variety widespread today all over the world, the William pear has been selected at the end of the eighteenth century in the English city of Aldernaston. It's a juicy fruit characterized by its typical aroma and is most used in industry for jams and juices. The summer William is ideal for salad fruits, milk shakes and cocktails.



CONFERENCE

Consumers really appreciate this sweet and juicy variety, we can find it on sale from beginning November to end of June.



KAISER

This variety can be easy identificated by its regular form and the uniformity of its brown peel. Juicy and crunchy is fit for fresh and cooking use.



DECANA DEL COMIZIO

Big and roundish, this fruit has been selected in Angers (France) at the beginning of the Nineteenth Century. For its sweet juicy and compact pulp this pear can really be good for cooking and specially for jams and juices.

Once was this variety more appreciated, but still today it has many appraisers thanks to the excellent quality of its pulp witch is also juicy and sweet-smelling. It is part of the summer pears and have to be handled with care.



ABATE FETEL

This pear represents one of the most requested variety and is intensively grown in Emilia Romagna, mostly in Modena and Ferrara provinces. The name was of a French monk who selected the pear tree in the middle of the fifteenth century. This fruit have a typical lengthened shape, a rusty green peel and a sweet-smelling pulp.



SANTA MARIA

This summer variety is quite juicy and characterized with a high productivity and an early fruit-bearing. For these interesting peculiarities its growing collects a great success in the mid.south of Italy. This pear can be consumed from the middle of July to the end of October.

Uva Italia

The market-leading white variety. it is appreciated by everybody for its productivity, appearance, excellent quality of crisp and slightly musk taste, sweetness (15-16%) and the resistance to long transports.



Red Globe

Big bunch. Big round and pink-coloured grape (9-10g). An excellent choice in the final supply phase both for the ripening and the good resistance to transports.



Víttoria

Table grapes white, very good for its earliness, productivity, appearance of the bunch and the berry. With excellent resistance to transport and shelf on the plant.



Palieri

Big bunch with nice appearance, especially thanks to the black-violet colour, it has a good resistance to transports.

Big grapes (9-10g), with oval shape, firm pulp, sweet with a neutral taste.







Queen

It is one of the most ancient vine, which is widespread in all Mediterranean countries, where it is known with many synonyms. It is excellent for its sweet taste and it resists enough to transports.



Black Pearl

Medium to large cluster sizes, medium-large grapes (5.5 to 6.5 g), with an elongated oval shape, dark red-bluish skin neutral.



Seedless

Berries with thick skin and crunchy structure devoid of any trace of semen, it tastes sweet and subtle Muscat relatively low acidity.



Black Magic

The skin of black grapes, but sour taste with a bitter aftertaste, perfectly suited for high-alcoholic wines.











Plum



It is an extremely refreshing fruit that also helps in regaining the liquids lost with sweating.

Thanks to a good quantity of mineral salts like potassium, calcium, phosphorus, it has an important depurative function for the organism.

Kíwi is rich in nutritive compounds and vitamins and contains fibre, potassium, magnesium, copper, and many vitamins like E and K, but most of all Vitamin C in a percentage which is even higher than in oranges and lemons.

These characteristics make it an advisable fruit, suitable for everyone.









Juicy and sweet

Peach is, par excellence, one of the summer fruits: fresh, sweet, thirst-quenching, versatile in its usage, and suitable for all diets.

Peach is rich in sugar, organic acids, provitamin A; has a low calorie content (27 Kcal/100 g), and it shows a juicy and fleshy texture, due to the high water content; 100 g of peach contain is almost three quarters of Vitamin C the daily recommended allowance (RDA).













Nectarine



Delicate and light

Nectarine, or "pesca noce" (nut peach), is different from peach (it has a velvety skin) the difference is in the skin (smooth and shinny).

It is rich, like its sister, in sugars, organic acids, and provitamin A. It has a low caloric content (27 Kcal/100 g) and it presents a fleshy and juicy texture, due to high water content.

The main reason for its commercial success depends on its smooth skin, as it is preferred taste with respect to the peach, especially to young consumers.

















The apricot is a yellow-orange stone fruit, with a red tone on the part exposed to the sun; it has got a pubescent and similar to velvet skin, a succulent and scented pulp and inside it there's a smooth stone with well defined sutures.

Thank you to the good quantity of proteins, calcium, potassium and vitamins, this fruit has got an appreciable nutritional and dietetic value.

This typical summer fruit can be considered as a true and real present of the nature for its high quantity of pro-vitamin A and vitamin C.





Cherry



Cherries are rich in flavonoids, useful for combatting free radicals. They are highly refreshing and contain large amounts of fibre, potassium, calcium, phosphorus, Vitamins A an d C.

Bigarreau

cherries are the first to appear on the market; since mid-May, and remain available until early June.

Black

these hard-fleshed cherries (corns) are available throughout the month of June. They are the pride of the production area of Vignola (MO): sweet, large, dark red or black.

Anella

these calluses are available from late May through June. The skin has a color ranging from bright red to dark red, the flesh is crisp and juicy. This special characteristic of this variety is particularly popular.

Railway

tenerine these cherries are grown primarily in Puglia, and are available in June. They are particularly appreciated for the juicy flesh.

Brand

the cornea is yellow-red and is particularly appreciated by the canning industry to produce syrup and cherries in brandy.











This is a pyramid-shaped and succulent fruit and it is covered by a more or less intense red and shining skin, with little dark seeds.

The strawberry increases your alkaline storage, it quenches your thirst and it has got a refreshing, anti-uric and depurative function. It is suitable for those who suffer of rheumatism and hypertension (in fact it improves the production of the hormones that strengthen the nervous system).













Clementine



Clementines have their origins in Algeria by a probable cross between the mandarin and bitter orange brown.

The strong orange peel is very thin. The flesh is very juicy . Orange is seedless. The growing region for excellence in Italy is Calabria, where the climate and soil give to the fruits high organoleptic characteristics..

Fruits seasonality chart




